
Factory Andy Warhol

andy warhol: prints exhibition extended through sept. 10 - curator sara krajewski, the book traces the development of warhol's printmaking practices and his exploration of the photographic image as source material through three time periods: the books and ephemera of the 1950s, the factory and factory additions (1963-1974) and andy warhol enterprises, inc.
